The Program

The Program is offered by the School of Philosophy of the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens (NKUA)



It is the first English-taught Bachelor's degree Program at a Greek University

It is available to international students

This innovative Program harmoniously and profoundly combines the sciences of Archaeology Ancient History and Classical literature.

It enriches the courses in classroom with on-site instruction in places of archeological and cultural interest

It includes six semester courses of systematic teaching of the ancient Greek language

The curriculum also includes a number of classes in Modern Greek, offered free of charge to all students during the first year of their studies.

The duration of the study program is four (4) years (eight academic semesters)

The total amount of ECTS required to successfully complete the program is 248 ECTS

The structure of the study program aims at the development of intellectual and cultural ties between Greece and other countries.

It contributes decisively to the promotion of the international character of Greek studies.

It already enjoys international recognition

It has signed bilateral agreements with renowned foreign universities and their students spend one year of study abroad at our university and in the program:

Southwest University (SWU), P.R. China University of Cincinnati, (UC), Ohio, U.S.A Northwest Normal University (NWNU), P. R. China Many other agreements are moving rapidly towards completion with countries such as the USA (some in the context of the International Academic Partnership Program [IAPP] Greece which was inaugurated by the Minister of Education) It organized in collaboration with the Boston University and the Study in Greece the summer school "Voyage into Greek Civilization"



This academic year, the number of students participating in it has impressively increased

Our freshmen: 37 students from 16 different countries. During the spring semester 25 students will be added for a semester of study abroad
