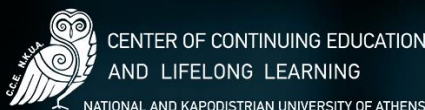


The Center of Continuing Education & Lifelong Learning of the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens welcomes you to the course entitled
