2nd CALL FOR PROPOSALS - WORKSHOPS ON INNOVATIVE PEDAGOGIES -


The CIVIS Alliance is launching, under Work Package 7 – Teaching Excellence, Task Force on Innovative Pedagogies, its second call for workshops on innovative pedagogies, to be designed and delivered by all partner universities starting with March 2022.

The positive feedback from the academics attending the workshops organized this year, and the significant number of facilitators interested in sharing innovative pedagogies encouraged us to extend and support these relevant peer learning experiences also this year.

Many resources and materials are being generated in all universities these last years. CIVIS workshops on innovative pedagogies have been demonstrated to effectively address our common challenges, share experiences, and develop communities and practice networks.

We encourage cooperation between academics, and we will support each university to initiate and coordinate one joint workshop on innovative pedagogies to be delivered in 2022. Additional to the support offered by the WP7 CIVIS coordinators in your university, financial support is also available to design and deliver the joint workshops.

PROCESS FOR SUBMISSION

Please note that all the proposals should be drafted and agreed upon with the local Innovative Pedagogies coordinators (see contact list below). The team is also available for consultation and support.

Please fill in this form (in English), providing details for the following sections:

- » The workshop's title
- » The university organizing the workshop + partner universities
- » Date, hours, and duration
- » Online platforms used
- » Language(s) of delivery the workshop can be delivered in any language of the Civis Alliance
- » Brief description $\frac{1}{2}$ page brief description of the workshop;
- » Target group teachers, students, or other functions and the maximum number of participants.
- » Focus on Innovative Pedagogies included based on the IP Handbook if the case.
- » A brief bio of the trainer(s) / facilitators with links to the professional profile and email addresses.
- » Available resources for the participants (if the case) references, books, articles, other support materials, etc.

The University of Bucharest team will manage the entire administrative process:

- » creating registration links,
- » providing facilitators with the list of registered participants
- » issuing the attendance certificates for all the participants





RESOURCES FOR SUBMISSION

Examples of pedagogical innovations already shared by the CIVIS academics can be found in the <u>Innovative Pedagogies:</u> <u>ways into the Process of Learning Transformation Handbook</u>. The handbook provides an in-depth analysis of the approaches that teachers are prepared to address the pedagogical innovations in the classroom.

You are invited to submit proposals approaching innovation typologies such as technology-based, methodology-based, skills-based, and context-driven pedagogical innovation, but also other types of innovation.

FELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR FINANCIAL SUPPORT TO DESIGN & DELIVER THE JOINT WORKSHOP<u>s</u>

To be eligible for financial support, a workshop should:

- » involve at least the cooperation of 3 universities (coordinator + at least two partners)
- » **involve a minimum of 12 hours of work, out of which 5 hours of synchronous delivery,** the rest being dedicated to self-paced learning, tutoring, discussions, evaluation, etc.

Each university can initiate and coordinate one joint workshop on Innovative Pedagogies, and the allocated amounts will be:

- » Coordinator 3000 EUR (incentives dedicated to the team working in designing, organizing, and delivering the workshop)
- » Partners 1500 EUR (incentives dedicated to partners for contributing to the workshop's design and delivery)

Conditions:

- » Each university is eligible (and expected) to come with one proposal of a workshop, as organizer (feel free to use/deploy ideas from 2021 or come up with something new);
- » Each workshop should have at least 3 partner institutions (organizer + 2 partners), but not more than 5 institutions (organizer + 4 partners)
- » Each university is eligible to participate as a partner in maximum 3 workshops

NOTE:

If members of the Alliance would like to propose for 2022 workshops without accessing this compensation scheme, they are free to do it, under the same conditions like as in 2021 (no incentives, no need for partners, no limitation in terms of duration). Nevertheless, given that the project ends in September 2022, we would very much encourage all partners to use the above-mentioned scheme mentioned above.
