## **3 types of Grants**

### **1. Standard Grants**

- Typically less than €5,000 / £5,000
- Open to any application of:
  - benefit to endocrine research
  - delivery of service with academic, clinical or public benefit
  - led by early career applicants



## 3 types of Grants

### 2. Travel Grants

- Typically less than €2,000 / £2,000
- Will consider support for a wide-range of activities, for example:
  - individuals seeking to gain additional experience, e.g. in an overseas lab / clinical centre
  - endocrinology researchers seeking to present work at non-endocrine international meetings



## **3 types of Grants**

### **3. Scientific Meeting Grants**

- Up to €10,000 / £10,000 to support small meetings
- Will not usually provide recurring support



## Application

- Application process aims to be simple and “light touch”
- Applications competitively assessed by the Trustees
- 3 grant rounds per year
