The important role played by Universities internationally, is reflected in the *Times Higher Education Impact Rankings 2020*, the only global performance tables that assess universities against the United Nations' Sustainable Development Goals. The National and Kapodistrian University of Athens, for instance, has been highly ranked in individual goals of economic and social development, confirming the significant impact it has as a University on improving social welfare, economic development, tackling social inequalities, education and health.

Most lately, also, the Shanghai Ranking ranked the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens among the top 1,3% best Universities in the world.

I am also very proud to mention that we have been **the first Greek university to launch an English undergraduate program**, the "*BA Program in the Archaeology, History and Literature of Ancient Greece*", the first undergraduate program in a Greek University that is especially designed for international students and all its courses are taught in English. From the next academic year 2022-23 a *Medical Degree program in English* will be also offered, exclusively addressed to foreign nationals.

In recent years, our University has grown significantly as far as new structures and infrastructures. Three major Core Facilities are already developed with high-end instrumentation which can be used for cutting edge research.

We are, also, let me mention, motivated about the European Universities Initiative.

The previous week we had the great honor and the unique opportunity to welcome here in Athens at the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens, the oldest Public University in our Country and in the hole area of the Balkans and the East Mediterranean more than 300 delegates for the GLOBAL CIVIS DAYS, <u>a unique event for our</u> <u>outstanding coalition!</u>

CIVIS's objectives for the next four years are in line with the European Strategy for Universities. The CIVIS alliance joins forces and invests in transnational cooperation to educate a new generation of European citizens on key contemporary challenges.
