The artist's Statement

The view through a window always provides a picture.

But if you look closely, there are several. You see what is behind the pane, as well as the reflection of what is opposite, the light that shines in different intensities and the shadows that are refracted through the glass.

I capture details of what I see from one point of view (at one time) on the surface. The change of perspective creates abstract images that continue to carry all the dimensions of a window.

Each form is comprehensible, but none has an inherent truth.
