During the morning session researchers on climate change coming from different disciplines in the National Kapodistrian University of Athens (NKUA) and Spanish universities will present their research and possible collaborations in the field.

In the afternoon session, representatives of the Alliance 4 Universities will present current research collaborations between four Spanish universities (UAB, UAM, UC3M and UPF) and the NKUA and other Greek universities. The NKUA and the A4U will inform about opportunities to strengthen collaborations, with a special emphasis on opportunities for young researchers.

The main target audience are teachers, researchers and students from all Greek universities. We welcome especially senior researchers and postdocs, as well as MA and PhD students in all disciplines.

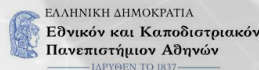
